We are requesting your assistance in distributing the information below inviting graduating high school students to apply for scholarship awards offered by The Atlanta Jamaican Association, Inc. (AJA).

AJA is a non-profit organization that was founded in 1977 to promote friendship, unity, and understanding between the peoples of Jamaica and the United States. As part of this effort, a scholarship program was established to assist college-bound high school students of Jamaican ancestry in the first year of their higher educational pursuits.

Candidates are required to submit an application which includes a Curriculum Vita (Resume), a one-page essay from a list of topics provided by the Education committee, and other requirements listed on the application. Involvement in school and community activities and academic ability will be additional factors in the selection of the recipients. Members of the AJA Education Committee will conduct virtual interviews with students who have been shortlisted and notify successful candidates by the end of **May 25, 2025**. The formal presentation of scholarships will take place at the Annual Atlanta Jamaican Association Independence Ball and Scholarship Awards Ceremony in Atlanta on **Saturday, August 9, 2025**.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must satisfy all requirements below:

- (1) An incoming first year student
 - At least one parent/guardian must be of Jamaican heritage.
 - Students applying from Jamaica can either be accepted to attend college or university in Jamaica or overseas with the requisite visa.
- (2) Demonstrate financial need.
- (3) Hold a minimum of 3.5 Grade Point Average or equivalent.
- (4) Provide proof of college acceptance.
- (5) Submit completed Application Form, signed Agreement, copy of Transcript, and curriculum vitae by the deadline date.
